


# INTERNATIONAL COLLABORATIONS IN TEACHING PROCESS (*DEMUSIS* PROJECT)




- Enhancement of teaching process through online teacher training at FoM by Lithuanian academy for music and theatre in Vilnius (Lithuania), the New Bulgarian University in Sofia (Bulgaria) in December 2020 and the Royal Conservatoire The Hague (Netherlands) in April 2021, in the fields of implementation digital and entrepreneurial skills and knowledge in higher music education, particularly in distance teaching and learning
- Moodle platform for distance learning <u>eLearning</u> installed and in use, with 41 courses offered and over 600 students enrolled to online courses




